



INTER-INSTITUCIONAL AGREEMENT

The "Asociación de la Industria Eléctrica – Electrónica de Chile", in short, AIE, represented by its President Raúl Cobo Zañartu, and the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers, in short, IEEE, represented by Director Emeritus, T.W. Hissey, both with due authorization, agree on the following:

BACKGROUND

The AIE and the IEEE, both professional institutions, have among their objectives the development and promotion of the electrical, electronics, and related areas of engineering, as well as the technical, professional, and human advancement of their members with the purpose of improving the quality of life of the community where they work.

AGREEMENT OBJECTIVE

The AIE and the IEEE Chile Section agree to coordinate efforts toward the creation of an annual/biannual AWARD to recognize the excellence in the carrying out of professional activities by part of their members.

The qualification of excellence in the performing of the profession will take into consideration the relevance of the technical and ethical aspects, as well as their positive impact in the community.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTS

The parts agree on the following:

- To define the award name and characteristics.
- To determine the requirements to be fulfilled by the candidates to the award.
- To establish the contest rules.
- To appoint the jury in charge of judging the candidates performance and awarding the prize/s.
- To appoint a permanent committee to organize and promote the contest.
